Communication, language and literacy

We will listen to a variety of stories, songs and rhymes for interest and enjoyment. We will read some of them many times so that we become really familiar with them such as Whatever Next, Burglar Bill and Stick Man. The children will be encouraged to role play and retell these in their own activities and also to invent their own versions to entertain others. We will continue to develop vocabulary through books and stories and encourage children to ask and answer questions about what they have seen and heard.

The children will also continue with Phase 2 phonics. As well as continually recapping the GPCs and words they know they will learn new phonemes and the graphemes that represent that sound. They will then use them in reading CVC words, as well as learning to read some more words from the tricky word list. We will also begin to write CVC words and learn to form all our letters correctly. We will keep practising writing our name and think about writing for a purpose as we celebrate different festivals eg. writing cards, invitations and lists etc.



Expressive arts and design

We will continue to practise our basic skills such as paint mixing, cutting, joining and observational drawings. We will also do lot of seasonal crafts and activities connected to the festivals we learn about eg. Diva lamps, poppies and Christmas decorations. We will continue to sing rhymes and songs as well as develop our ability to listen and respond to different kinds of music. Our Christmas performance will give us an opportunity to dance and sing on the stage with KS1 and we hope you will join us as our live audience!

Mathematics



We will be looking at the numbers 1 – 5 and learning to recognise them in many different representations, compare them and think about their composition (all the different ways of making each number). This isn't as simple as it may sound and further information about how we teach maths will be given at the maths workshop in January. We will also be learning to use the language of "one more and one less". Our shape work is all about circles, triangles and 4 sided shapes and we will be looking at positional language too.

Personal, social and emotional development

We will be thinking about sharing and how to consider the feelings of others as well as being able to express their own feelings.



Understanding the world



We will be talking about festivals and celebrations. These will include Birthdays, Diwali, Bonfire Night, Remembrance and Christmas.

Physical development



In our weekly PE lessons we will be learning about how to jump and land safely whilst thinking about working sensibly, taking turns and sharing with others. We will also be using the running track and our bikes and scooters regularly as well as handling large scale construction equipment to help develop our gross motor skills.

Our fine motor skills will be developed with regular activities to help us with pencil control and handwriting.
